

ACADEMIC AWARDS

Class Pins are awarded by Campbell Collegiate to students who achieve a **minimum of 79.5 %** based on six courses in Grade 9 and 12 and seven courses in Grade 10 and 11. **Required class marks can be taken from ANY school year (eg. If student takes History 30 while in grade 11, that History 30 mark can be used to calculate a student's grade 12 average). Elective subject marks will only be considered from the current school year.** Students spending only a partial year at Campbell can apply to the office to be considered for a class pin based on external courses.

Grade 9 pin averages are calculated using the following six courses instructed in English or in French:

- One Language Arts 09 class (ELA 09 or French Immersion 09)
- One Math 09 class
- One Science 09 class
- One Social Studies 09 class
- Two current year additional classes

Grade 10 class pin averages are calculated using the following seven courses:

- Two credits from Language Arts 10 class (English A10, English B10, or François 10)
- One credit from Math 10 class (Foundations of Math and Pre-Calculus 10, Math 11, Workplace and Apprenticeship Math 10, or Foundations of Math and Pre-Calculus (AP) 10)
- One credit from Science 10 class or Science 10 (AP) class
- One credit from a Social Science 10 class (History 10, Native Studies 10, Sciences Humaines 10)
- Two current year additional classes

Grade 11 class pin averages are calculated using:

- One credit from Language Arts 20 class (English 20, English 20 (IB/AP), or François 20)
- One credit from Science 20 (Health Science 20, Environmental Science 20, Physical Science 20, Computer Science 20)
- One credit from Math 20 (Foundations 20, Pre-calculus 20, Workplace 20, Fondements 20 or Math 21)
- Four additional current year electives (may include World Literature 20 (IB), History 20 or French Immersion Integre A20)

Grade 12 class pin averages are calculated using:

- Two credits from Language Arts 30 (English A30, English B30 or François 30)
- One credit from Social Science 30 (History 30, History 30 (IB/AP), Native Studies 30, Social Studies 30 or Science Social 30)
- Three additional current year electives
